



## AWTA Ltd Climate Statement

AWTA understands the role that climate change is having, and will continue to have, on our businesses and those of our major clients in the Australian and New Zealand wool and agricultural industries.

As a responsible corporate citizen, we are committed to taking measures to mitigate climate risks. We need to reduce our impact on the climate by reducing our absolute greenhouse gas emissions and by promoting sustainable business practices.

To do this, AWTA will implement the recommendations of the Task Force on Climate-related Financial Disclosures (TCFD). AWTA's climate-related reporting will evolve as climate and sustainability regulations change.

**Our interim climate goal is to reach a 30% reduction in Scope 1 and Scope 2 Emissions from our operations by 2030, which is in line with international objectives of limiting global warming to 1.5°C.**

The strategies and actions required to achieve this climate goal will be directed and monitored by the AWTA Board, and actioned by each AWTA Division, led by the CEO, in line with the AWTA Climate Change Policy and Climate Action Plans.

Regular reports on progress will be available to all key stakeholders.
